Memorandum For the Record.

On 16 June, Mr. Klein called re' the advance leave of Mr. Friedman. At Mr. Klein's request, a check was made with Mr. Galy, Payroll and it was determined that Mr. Friedman's advance sick leave would expire on 21 June.

In addition it was determined that Mr. F. had 202 hours annual leave to his credit as of 11 June and that he would accrue an additional 120 hours as of the end of the leave year.

Also, at the end of the leave year Mr. F would have a deficit of 181 hours sick leave to repay.
