TO: Judge Advocate General, Department of the Army, The Pentagon

1. I note that the subject bill is identical with those introduced in the last Congress. My views remain in all respects those expressed in the indorsement referred to in paragraph 1 of the basic letter.

2. Mr. Friedman's current Civil Service title is Research Consultant; his organizational title is Special Assistant (to the Director). His compensation was increased on 29 April 1951 from \$10,750 per year to \$11,000 per year (step increase) and to \$11,800 on 27 October 1951 (general pay increase).
