ONE INTERESTING BRITISH INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITY ALLIED WITH PARK IS ORGANIZATION WHICH LISTENS TO GERMAN WESTERN FRONT AIR TO GROUND AND AIR TO AIR TRAFFIC CMA WHICH IS BY VOICE TELEPHONE PD TO SEARCH FOR CLARKE FROM MCCORMACK PD. THERE ARE INTERCEPT STATIONS IN CONSIDERABLE NUMBER LOCATED ALONG COAST FROM YARMOUTH DOWN PD STATIONS ARE MANNED BY GERMAN SPEAKING WOMEN WHO TAKE DOWN CONVERSATIONS AND REPORT THEM TO NEAREST GROUP HEADQUARTERS OF RAF PD COOPERS STATION GETS TEXTS CMA EXAMINES THEM FOR INTELLIGENCE CONTENT CMA AND SENDS BACK TO LISTENING STATION'S HINTS ABOUT WORDS USED OR MISTAKES MADE CMA SO AS TO IMPROVE THEIR LISTENING PD SOME OF CONVERSATIONS OVERHEARD ARE THOSE IN ACTUAL COMBAT AND ARE USED TO STUDY GERMAN REACTIONS TO ALLIED INITIATIVE INFORMATION IS DERIVED CMA AND THEY ARE USEFUL IN BUILDING-UP JAPION OF PARTICULAR GA F UNITS PD SOME OF THIS STUFF IS RECORDED AND USED FOR TRAINING
