Subject: Visits to U.K.

The following information, received from SUSLO, London is provided to the members of USCIB:

"ANTICIPATE HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS IN UK WILL BECOME EXTREMELY CRITICAL DURING TOURIST PERIOD MAY THROUGH SEPT. SCHEDULING OF OFFICIAL VISITS TO UK DURING ABOVE PERIOD SHOULD BE PLANNED AS FAR IN ADVANCE AS PRACTICABLE. MINIMUM OF 14 DAYS REQUIRED PRIOR DATE OF ARRIVAL. IMPERATIVE INFO PROVIDED SUSLO INCLUDE FIRM DATE OF ARRIVAL, LENGTH OF STAY AND TYPE ACCOMMODATION REQUIRED. A DEPARTURE FROM SCHEDULE MUST BE PROVIDED SUSLO PROMPTLY OTHERWISE TRAVELLER WILL BE PRESENTED WITH HOTEL BILL IF NOTIFICATION OF CANCELLATION NOT PROVIDED. CANCELLATIONS MUST BE MADE AT LEAST 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE. ABOVE DUPLICATES CINCPAC, THIRD AIR FORCE AND ATTACHE INSTRUCTIONS."
