1. Vote sheet replies to the reference indicate approval by all members with the following exceptions:

a. STATE: Approved, subject to the following:

"Para 10b of Enclosure 3 (Minimum Security Standards) appears to imply that there may be some IIS materials which the [REDACTED] may make available to non-[REDACTED] personnel. This would be inconsistent with the principle enumerated in para g of the statement of objectives and the provision contained within para 4 of the aide memoire. I suggest that this subpara be deleted and that subpara 10a of Enclosure 3 be altered to accommodate this deletion."

b. CIA: "Desire paper be considered at next regular meeting of USCIBEC."

2. Accordingly, the reference will be placed on the agenda for consideration at the 25th meeting of USCIBEC.
