Subject: Program to Improve the Communications Security
of NATO Countries.

Reference: USCIB 29.1/17 of 3 February 1954.

1. This office has been advised by the National Security Agency that paragraph 3b of enclosure 5 with USCIB 29.1/6 (revised 3 February 1954 and circulated with the reference) reveals certain crypt intelligence. The entire document should therefore be designated by the appropriate codeword and the cover memorandum therefor (the reference) appropriately annotated.

2. Owing to the nature and intended use of this document, it is being suggested to the Combined Working Group that an attempt be made to find a means of expressing their intent in terms that would not require use of the codeword.
