At the end of 10 or 15 minutes someone decided that he would have to be treated as a visitor. By this time Mr. Howard was afraid he might miss his appointment at the Pentagon and left. Shortly thereafter Mr. Howard's badge was located and authorized to be given to him.

Chief Sample called me, concerned that Mr. Howard had gone, and assured me that his badge was available.

Mr. Howard called me later to say he had missed us. He was not unduly upset about the delay, but he can hardly have been encouraged by it.

Incidents like this must be kept to an absolute minimum if we are to hold the respect and cooperation of the members of SCAG.
