Claim 2 is rejected on the grounds of being  
indefinite in the recital of "or non" in line 7.

Claim 2, line 12, the second "said" occurring  
at the end of the line should be canceled.

Claims 3, 4 are rejected for the same reasons as  
claim 2.

Claim 8 is rejected on the grounds of failing to  
particularly point out and to distinctly claim the invention.

Claim 9 is rejected on the grounds of setting forth  
an unpatentable method. The steps recited appear to be no  
more than the normal function of the apparatus.

Claims 1, 5, 6, 7 appear at present to be allowable.
