MEMORANDUM for Assistant Chief of Staff, G-2, War Department.

1. Under date of 23 March 1944, G-2 authority was granted to recommend to the Department of State a plan for improving that Department's cryptographic communications. The principal feature of that plan was that of making Converter M-325 available. (Tab A)
